- If you are interested in studying abroad, please let your academic advisor know as soon as possible so you can meet to discuss study abroad goals and how they fit into your specific academic program and graduation requirements.
- Students typically study abroad between their second semester of sophomore year through their senior year. The decision when to study abroad should be made in consultation with the student's academic advisor, to ensure it fits with their academic program.
- Students studying for a semester or a full year should have completed a minimum of 8 out of the 10 general education requirements prior to studying abroad. The math and college writing requirements must be met before students study abroad. Students should also have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75. Specific program requirements may be higher.
- Students studying in summer programs are required to have a minimum grade point average of 2.75. Students are not required to complete a specified number of general education requirements prior to participating in a summer program and graduation requirements.
