



Study Abroad for Premedical Students

AU Abroad, in consultation with the **Premedical Program** offers a selection of programs suited for students who are planning a career in medicine or one of the allied health professions.

These programs are recommended on the basis of their academic quality and their relevance to students in the premedical field. In addition to the following programs, other options are available through AU Abroad.

Premedical Guidelines for Study Abroad

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- The Premedical Program recommends that students study abroad during their junior or senior year or during the summer. Students should study abroad for no more than one semester.
- If you are interested in studying abroad, please let the premed programs coordinator know as soon as possible so you can set up a schedule of classes that completes all the premedical requirements and includes your study abroad experience.
- Premedical students can take health courses abroad, upper level biology, chemistry or physics as well as courses related to public and global health. The core requirements for medical, dental, veterinary and pharmacy schools should not be taken abroad.
- Students may find more courses available to them abroad in their primary major. Please also see the major advising sheets for these subjects when considering your study abroad location.

MEDICINE/BIOSCIENCE

Australia

Murdoch University

Students take courses within the veterinary and biomedical sciences discipline areas

University of Melbourne

Courses are offered in a variety of topics including animal science, neuroscience and anatomy

England

King's College London

KCL is the largest center for education of doctors, dentists and healthcare professionals in Europe. Students take courses at the School of Biomedical & Health Sciences

University College of London

Study abroad students take courses in the biomedical sciences including anatomy, zoology and neurobiology

University of Exeter

Courses are offered in a wide range of topics such as animal biology, zoology, human bioscience, and medicinal chemistry.

Ireland

Courses are offered in a range of topics such as HIV/AIDs in Africa, epidemiology, and pregnancy, birth and infancy. Courses in the medicine/bioscience area are also available.
