### Europe

**England: School of Oriental and Asian Studies** - Study at the United Kingdom's premier institution for Oriental and African Studies! A wide range of language and area studies is available to you, including Africa, the Middle East and Asia.

**Denmark: Copenhagen (DIS)** - Denmark's Institute for Study Abroad offers coursework in Anthropology, including Migration and Identity. ### Australia/New Zealand
