- The Department recommends going abroad during the junior year or the first semester of the senior year.
- To receive Psychology credit for any courses taken abroad, you must have the courses approved by the Chair of the AU Department of Psychology before you take them. Retroactive approvals will not be given. Should classes close prior to your arrival at the host institution, you need to submit approval requests via e-mail to the Psychology Chair before registering for additional classes.
- Psychology majors can count up to 6 credit hours of <u>pre-approved</u> courses, taken while abroad, toward their major course requirements. Courses under consideration must be offered by the Psychology Department at the host institution.
- To have a course pre-approved requires the submission of a detailed course syllabus to the Chair of the Department of Psychology, along with your study abroad course form. You should schedule an appointment with the Department Chair.
- If you are interested in studying abroad, please let your academic advisor know <u>as soon as possible</u> so you can set up a schedule of classes that completes all the degree requirements and includes your study abroad experience.
- If you are premed, you can go abroad! Many programs offer courses (counted as elective credit) on topical biomedical subjects.
