- The Department recommends going abroad anytime between the summer after sophomore year through the first semester of senior year.
- ENVS majors can count up to 9 credit hours of <u>pre-approved</u> courses, taken while abroad, to- ward their upper-level major course require-ments.
- To have a course "pre-approved" requires the submission of a detailed course description and a syllabus. Materials should be submitted to your faculty advisor in a timely manner. Its highly recommended that you schedule an appointment with your faculty advisor in-advance and do not expect immediate approval of a course upon request. Approval requires a review of your overall course of study.

Due to the sequencing of courses, if you are interested in studying abroad, please let your academic advisor know as soon as possible so you can set up a schedule of classes that completes all the degree requirements and includes your study abroad experience.

Australia

Murdoch University (Australearn)

Murdoch University offers a wide range of courses in Ecotourism, Environmental Management, Environmental Restoration, and Sustainable Development.

University of Queensland (Australearn)

UQ's program in Environmental Science offers four specializations, including Earth Resources, Ecology, Molecular and Microbial Science, and Natural Resource Science.

University of New South Wales

The School of Biological, Earth and Environmental Sciences (BEES) incorporates environmentally relevant disciplines with social, economics and legal aspects of environmental science.

Chile

Santiago Program

Hosted by Universidad Diego Portales, the program offers courses taught in Spanish alongside other US students on the program. Advanced students can also take one course taught in Spanish alongside local students. The program requires two years of college level Spanish or the equivalent. The program offers a rich analysis of the contemporary issues that affect Chile and Latin America within a context of the world stage, such as global climate change, sustainable development, poverty, social issues, globalization, politics, and Spanish language.

Costa Rica

Institute For Study Abroad (IFSA)
