- Students may study abroad between their second semester of sophomore year through their senior year. The decision when to study abroad should be made in consultation with the student's academic advisor, to ensure it fits with their academic program.
- If you are interested in studying abroad, please let your academic advisor know as soon as possible so you can set up a schedule of classes that completes all the degree requirements and includes your study abroad experience.
- The number of credits accepted into the CLEG major will vary. Students should work with their academic counselor to discuss individual programs.
- To have a course "pre-approved" requires the submission of a detailed course description and syllabus if possible. It is highly recommended that you schedule an appointment with your advisor in -advance. ALL course descriptions or syllabi must be in English.
- All classes for major credit must be completed on the A/F scale. No coursework from an abroad location can be used as the equivalent to the CLEG Seminar, GOVT-489.
