- Students may study abroad between their second semester of sophomore year through their senior year. The decision when to study abroad should be made in consultation with the student's academic advisor, to ensure it fits with their academic program.
- If you are interested in studying abroad, please let your academic advisor know as soon as possible so you can set up a schedule of classes that completes all the degree requirements and includes your study abroad experience.
- The Department of Government allows up to six credits of approved GOVT coursework in the body of the major. Three credits of GOVT coursework can apply to the minor.
- Additional coursework in fields such as History, International Studies and Sociology may apply to the Major Related Social Science requirement. Please speak with your academic advisor to determine if this is an option for you.
 - To have courses approved students must submit course descriptions, along with the completed course approval form, to their academic advisor.
