- Students may study abroad between their second semester of sophomore year through their senior year. The decision when to study abroad should be made in consultation with the student's academic advisor, to ensure it fits with their academic program.
- Students studying for a semester or a full year should have completed a minimum of eight out of the ten general education requirements prior to studying abroad. Students should also have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75. Specific program requirements may be higher.
- Students studying in summer programs are required to have a minimum grade point average of 2.75. Students are not required to complete a specified number of general education requirements prior to participating in a summer program option.
- If you are interested in studying abroad, please let your academic advisor know as soon as possible so you can meet to discuss study abroad goals and how they fit into your specific academic program and graduation requirements.

### **Canada**

#### **University of Toronto**

You can take courses from the full curriculum of UT, situated in the dynamic, multicultural city of Toronto. UT presents the opportunity to study Peace and Conflict Resolution from the perspective of our neighbor to the north.

#### **Carleton University**

You will have access to the full curriculum at Carleton, while taking advantage of its location in the national capital of Ottawa. You will be able to study the development of political infrastructure in areas emerging from recent conflicts.

### **France**

#### **Institute d'Etudes Politiques, Lille**

A highly specialized institution of international relations, Sciences Po Lille offers you the opportunity to study peace and conflict issues from a policy perspective from the French viewpoint. 4 semesters of French required; 6 recommended.

### **Ghana**

#### **University of Ghana at Legon**

Offered in partnership with CIEE, you may elect to enroll directly in a full load of courses at Legon, where you will have access to the most sophisticated international political studies program in the region, and may have the possibility of taking an internship related to your field.

### **Israel**

#### **The University of Haifa**

Outstanding in the field of Peace and Conflict Studies, Haifa has been in the forefront of study and research in the field. Courses offered instructed in English. Students are encouraged to study Hebrew and/or Arabic.

### **Hebrew University of Jerusalem**

The Rothberg International School offers students the opportunity to study the theory and reality of Middle East Peace in a city at the crossroads of conflict.

### **Jordan**

#### **Language and Culture**

In addition to studying Arabic Language and Arab cultures, you will have the opportunity to study the Paths to Peace in the Middle East (Fall only).

### **Korea**

#### **Yonsei University**

For the student interested in North and East Asia, Yonsei University offers you the opportunity to study Peace and Conflict Resolution, particularly the North/South context and Japan's relationship with the region. Courses are instructed in English.

### **New Zealand**

#### **Victoria University of Wellington**

Vic U. has a robust course program which will allow you an interdisciplinary approach to theory and practice with special attention paid to the Pacific region.

### **South Africa**

#### **University of KwaZulu Natal**
