- Students may study abroad between their second semester of sophomore year through their senior year. The Literature Department recommends that students study abroad during their junior year.
- If you are interested in studying abroad, please let your academic advisor know as soon as possible so you can meet to discuss your study abroad goals and how they fit into your specific academic program.
- Literature majors can count up to six credit hours of pre-approved courses, taken while abroad, towards their upper-level major course requirements. Additional courses under consideration for credit must be pre-approved by the Director of Undergraduate Studies.
- Courses are approved on a case-by-case basis so it is highly recommended that you schedule an appointment with the Literature Department to discuss course equivalencies in advance. Please be sure to submit a detailed course description and syllabus for each course with your request.
