- If you are interested in studying abroad, please let your academic advisor know as soon as possible so you can meet to discuss study abroad goals and how they fit into your specific academic program and graduation requirements.
- Generally, students may study abroad between their second semester of sophomore year through their senior year. The decision when to study abroad should be made in consultation with the student's academic advisor, to ensure it fits with their academic program.
- SOC only allows **6 credits** of approved COMM courses for a **major** when students study abroad, and only **3 credits** of an approved COMM course for a **minor**. Students studying abroad typically receive approval for COMM credits that are media studies based. *Media studies based can be the study of the media in X city or geographic region, how media influences X, media and women, new media effects on society/ news, language in the media, issues in the media, etc.*
- To have courses approved students must submit course descriptions, along with the completed course approval form, to their academic advisor.
